Load-In: is Sunday November 27th at 3:00pm @ SCPA then over to Stoughton High School Auditorium.

Tech Rehearsal: is Monday November 28th at 6:00pm

Dress Rehearsal: is Wednesday November 30th at 6:00pm

Starting the week of Monday, November 28th. ALL rehearsals will be at the Stoughton High School Auditorium located at 600 Lincoln Ave. Use the parking lot located off the west side of the building or the back side of the building.

Please come to a meeting on 10/27 at 12:00pm concerning your daughter's hair for performance. Please meet in the upstairs lobby.

Side Note

Please check your performer's shoes and tights to make sure they are in good condition for the performance. If needed, they are available for purchase in our front office. **If you are not sure what color tights, type of shoe, or hair style you will be wearing please check with Mary-Carel in the costume shop.**

Public Performances are Saturday December 3rd at 1.30 & 7.30pm

(calls at 11:30am and 5:30pm) Your make-up call may be before or after these times; you must be at the earlier call time. *You must arrive with your hair completed.* Be on time and ready to start.

The following cast members are required to be at warm-up: Clara, Soloists, Snow, Dolls, Spanish, Marzipan, Chinese, Waltz, Russian and Arabian.

There is no videotaping or flash photography allowed during any of the rehearsals or performances.

Rehearsals are closed. *There are no parents allowed in the dressing rooms or the backstage area during rehearsals or performances unless you've been assigned to work. NO ONE (including performers) is allowed in the audience during rehearsals or performances. There is a phone in the backstage area to call for a ride when performers are finished.*

Please eat prior to arrival – no food or drink is allowed in any of the dressing rooms, hallways, or in the backstage area.

Costumes

ABSOLUTELY NO ONE, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, IS ALLOWED TO EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING IN THEIR COSTUMES. *This is very important!* We have spent thousands of dollars on costumes, many of which are not replaceable. No food, drink (including water), candy, or gum in your costume.

Traditionally, after the performances, dancers have greeted friends and family in the lobby in their costumes. Kindly make your visit brief as dressers are waiting for you to return costumes for the next performance or for load out of the theatre. Please remember that no GUEST or PARENTS are allowed to return to the Dressing Room or Backstage Area with you after the performances.
